Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- Over the course of the month, the following fixed penalty tickets were issued in relation to Road Traffic offences:
- On 12th April 2018, a male driver was issued with a ticket for not having vehicle Insurance in the Gullane area.
- On 13th April, a male driver was issued with a ticket for careless driving in Gullane following a vehicular accident.
- On 18th April 2018, a male driver was issued with a ticket in relation to using a hand held device whilst driving in the Luffness area.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- There are no issues regarding anti-social behaviour to report this month.

3. Housebreaking

- There are no reports of housebreakings over the past month.

4. Parking

- During the month of March 2018, 7 parking tickets were issued in Gullane and 0 in Aberlady by East Lothian Council Parking attendants. This figure includes the coastal car park area of Yellowcraigs.

CAPP

The current priorities are:

1. Noisy vehicles in North Berwick.
2. Speeding vehicles in North Berwick
3. Speeding in the Gullane, Aberlady, Dirleton areas.

Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- On the 31st March 2018, the site manager at Cala Homes, Gullane reported the theft of a quantity of scaffolding from the site, which had occurred between 24th March 2018 and that date. Enquiries are ongoing.
- Between 8th April 2018 and 15th April 2018, a vehicle was damaged whilst parked in The Pleasance, Aberlady. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- On 20th April 2018, the owner of Duck's Hotel, Aberlady reported a fraud after a customer left the premises without paying their full bill. Enquiries are still ongoing to locate this person.
- Between 24th and 25th April 2018, two vehicles were damaged whilst parked in Hopeton Park, Gullane. Enquiries are still ongoing.
