Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- During the afternoon of Friday 15th February 2019, a 2 vehicle road traffic collision occurred on the A198 on the west side of Gullane village. Two persons remain in hospital at this time as a result of the accident.
- During the Month there were three calls about vehicles driving dangerously or speeding, unfortunately on all occasions the wrong registration numbers were passed therefore making any further enquiry difficult

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- During the evening of 20th February 2019 two cars parked up in the Main Street Gullane where they played loud music attracting numerous other youths. Youths got rather boisterous and Police were called. Before Police attended the informant called back to say they had all moved on.

3. Housebreaking

- Between 8th and 16th February 2019, a break in occurred to a dwelling house in Muirfield Station, Gullane. A quantity of jewellery and an ipad was stolen from within as well as a vehicle from the driveway, which was later recovered in Hall Crescent, Gullane. Enquiries are ongoing.
- Overnight 20th to 21st February 2019 an attempt break-in was recorded at Ballencreiff Steadings. Marks found on the door and plant pots moved. Enquiries are ongoing
