Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- Several complaints were received regarding the parking of vehicles in relation to the building site, Main Street, Gullane. On the occasions when Police attended they were parked legally.
- On 20th April 2019 a collision between a motor bike and a car happened at Rosebery Place Gullane. The rider of the motor bike injured his thumb and the bike and car were both damaged.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- On Saturday 30th March, after a report of a car having crashed into the barriers at Gullane Bents a male was subsequently traced and charged with drink driving.
- On Saturday 6th April, 6 vehicle with loud engines were seen heading towards Yellowcraigs car park. Due to previous knowledge of cars doing 'doughnuts', the police were called. Police attended where there were a couple of cars driving about but not 'ripping up' the car park. Advice was given and they have been sent on their way.

Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- During the month there have been several reports of person's hare coursing in the Ward area, if these persons are seen Police to be contacted and descriptions of persons, dogs and vehicle passed.
- On the morning of Saturday 30th March 2019 a report was received by Police of a vehicle accident at Gullane Bents on Police arrival a 17 yo male identified himself as the driver he subsequently failed the road side breath test, arrested and conveyed to Dalkeith where he was charged with drink driving.
- Between 1700hrs on 31st march and 1200hrs April 1st a car wing mirror was damaged whilst parked outside a house in High Street Aberlady. A hit and run crime report has been raised
- On Friday 12th April, police were contacted following a report of the theft of fuel from farm machinery near Whitekirk. Police attended and a 51 year old man was arrested and charged in connection with the theft.
