### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- During the morning of Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March, the police were called to an accident between a cyclist and a car. Minor injuries to the cyclist. Insurance details passed to cyclist. Enquires ongoing to establish if there was fault.
- During the evening of 1<sup>st</sup> March, Police stopped a vehicle driving on Main Street, Gullane, which was not insured and driver was only a provisional driving licence holder. Driver was charged accordingly and the vehicle seized.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- Police received calls between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> March regarding loud music being played in Muirfield Terrace, Gullane. These were either passed onto the East Lothian Council Noise Team or had stopped prior to police being able to attend.
- In the afternoon of Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> March, police were called to 2 cars driving around a grassy area next to the car park at Yellowcraigs beach churning up the grass. No trace of vehicles involved.

#### 3. Housebreaking

- Overnight between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> March, police received a report of a possible break in to a property in Gullane, however the owners were currently on holiday. Police attended and although property insecure, nothing stolen or damaged. Property was secured. On return, the owners confirmed nothing had been stolen and was probably left insecure in error.

#### 4. Parking - February 2019 issued by ELC

- Aberlady – 8 PCN's + (22 outside Nature Reserve)
- Gullane – 1 PCN's + 27 PCN's at Gullane Bents
- Yellowcraigs - 49 PCN's

### CAPP

The date of the next CAPP meeting is on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019, 1930 hours, Council Chambers, North Berwick. The agreed priorities from the previous meeting were:

1. Speeding in Lochbridge Road North Berwick
2. Careless driving along the B1345 Dirleton to Drem Road
3. Dog fouling in the Ward area paying particular attention to playing field.

### Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- During the Month there have been several reports of persons Hare coursing in the Ward area, if these persons are seen Police to be contacted and descriptions of persons, dogs and vehicle passed.
- Overnight into the 7<sup>th</sup> March 2019 a key safe was tampered with at the Goose Green Bakery, an attempt to remove the key was unsuccessful. Key safe has since been removed. Enquiries ongoing.
- On the 8<sup>th</sup> March 2019 in Hall Crescent Gullane a window cleaner was charged with cleaning windows without a licence.
- On Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> March, in Longniddry Bents Car Park no 3, a report was received regarding a male acting in a sexually suggestive manner towards a female. Police attended and the male identified. He was taken to Dalkeith and cautioned and charged with causing fear and alarm with a sexual aggravation.
- On Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March, the Co-op in Gullane reported a theft of alcohol and meat. A group of 2 males and 2 females were caught on CCTV stealing same. They have all since been identified and will be charged in the near future.
- Police received a report of an untaxed and uninsured vehicle parked in Dirleton. Reported to DVLA.
