### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- Police have received calls regarding cars parked near the junction of Muirfield Terrace and Muirfield Drive, Gullane. Police have attended these calls however the vehicles have not been parked illegally and were not causing an obstruction.
- On 26<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at Ballencrieff a cyclist and a lorry were involved in an accident, investigation confirmed the lorry did not hit the cyclist but in fact the cyclist fell in the path of the lorry. The cyclist did suffer significant injuries but nothing life threatening.
- A vehicle accident occurred at Kingston crossroads on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2019 both vehicles damaged only slight injury to one driver.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- In the evening of Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> July, various complaints were received regarding a loud house party in Aberlady. Details taken and passed on to East Lothian Noise Team.
- A call was received in the evening of Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> August regarding cars in Longniddry Car Park no 3 racing each other and doing donuts in the car park. Police attended. There was a positive drugs search whilst carrying out a search of these vehicles. Male accused received a recorded police warning for the possession of drugs.

#### 3. Housebreaking

- Overnight between 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> July, there has been an attempt break in to a garage in Aberlady. No entry gained and nothing stolen. Enquiries currently ongoing.

#### 4. Parking - July 2019 issued by ELC

- Aberlady - 5 PCN's (5 outside Nature Reserve)
- Gullane - 8 PCN's + 91 PCN's at Gullane Bents
- Yellowcraigs - 60 PCN's at Yellowcraigs
