### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- On Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June, a call came in regarding a car tailgating on the A198. Police already aware of vehicle and issued the driver with an ASBO.
- In the evening of Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June, whilst on mobile patrol in Aberlady, a vehicle was stopped and the driver found to be a disqualified driver and did not have an insurance policy to drive the vehicle. Driver cautioned and charged.
- In the early morning of Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June, a vehicle was seen by officers to drive in a careless manner in Muirfield Drive, Gullane. Driver spoken to and issued with an ASB fixed penalty.
- In the early morning of Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June, a vehicle was seen by officers to drive at excessive speed and driving carelessly in Aberlady. Driver spoken to and issued with an ASB fixed penalty.
- Around 1245 on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June, a 47 year old man died following the collision between his silver Audi A4 and a black Ford Fiesta on the A198 near Dirleton. The 25 year old male driver of the Ford Fiesta was taken to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary for treatment to non-life threatening injuries. Enquiries are ongoing.
- On Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June, road checks were conducted on the A198 at Aberlady. Several drivers were warned about their manner of driving, 1 reported to PF for careless driving and 1 reported for no insurance and possession of drugs.
- On Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> June, call received regarding a car continuingly driving dangerously in the Gullane area. Vehicle details taken and passed to local officers to keep a look out.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- On Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June, a male was charged with minor assault in Gullane. Reported for summons.
